The Forum will also identify emerging women's issues brought on by a changing world and seek government accountability for their commitments made to women's rights, equality and empowerment initiatives.

The outcome of the NGO Forum will feed into the ECE Regional Review Process and contribute to the Global Beijing+20 Report, as well as, the post-MDG agenda.
